



Courtesy Reciprocal Agreement

Purpose: To provide members of Deeside and Harewood Downs with an alternative course to play on an occasional basis, without additional charge adding value to their membership.

- Members must speak to a member of staff in their own Club's office or Pro Shop in order that they can phone the respective club's Pro Shop. In all cases, bookings will be subject to availability. Details of players' names must be communicated to the Club.
- Applications for group bookings in excess of 8 players would be considered on individual merit.
- On arrival at the club the players should report to the Pro Shop and sign in before playing.
- The scheme will operate Monday to Friday subject to availability. In order to provide a benefit to those Full Members who can only play at weekends, the scheme will also operate on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays after 12.30pm. Courtesy will also be offered if a member is playing with a member of the "home" club on a Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday morning. This must also be communicated in advance.
- No attempt should be made to introduce people who are not members of the two clubs without payment of the appropriate green fee. Any non-members playing with members of the reciprocal club will pay member guest green fees.
- There will be no discount on food and drinks as part of this agreement.
- This agreement does not include courtesy for members of each club visiting the other as part of a golf day / society.
- The scheme is to operate on an initial twelve-month basis but is subject to change by either Club at any stage.
